

ADVANCED BEGINNER COURSE

Once you've completed our Beginner Course series, surprise, you become Advanced Beginners. The Advanced Beginner course works like all our Intermediate and Advanced courses at Honors with each session being completely independent of one another. The complete weekly class schedule of our three Advanced Beginner courses can be found below. Please email the instructor whenever you wish to attend. The two morning classes will begin with different topics. The idea is to have it so that you will be able to jump in at any point along the way.
